### Arneis 2018

Fontanafredda Pradalupo Roero Arneis, Italy  
*Bright citrus, apples and loquat with herbal undertones.*  
Score - 91. (James Suckling, jmessuckling.com, Nov. 7, 2019)

### Pinot Grigio 2019

Bollini Pinot Grigio, Italy  
*Straw yellow in colour, clear-cut and delicate on the nose, with scents of acacia flowers, minerals and pear.*  
*The fresh natural acidity supports the wine.*

### Chardonnay

Calmel & Joseph Villa Roussillon, France  
*Pale lemon in colour, moderate aromas of citrus, apple and white peach. A touch tropical with melon and floral notes.*

### Riesling 2014

Willm Réserve, France  
*An array of succulent peach, grapefruit, apple and orange citrus flavours with some sage honey notes.*  
Score - 90. (Wine Spectator)

### Sauvignon Blanc 2019

Invivo, New Zealand  
*Fabulously fruited and intensely aromatic, the bouquet shows passionfruit, feijoa and green rockmelon characters with a hint of musky complexity.*  
Score - 94. (Sam Kim, winesorbit.co.nz, Sept. 2020)

### Prosecco

Villa Sandi Treviso, Italy  
*Fine Italian bubbly. Pours a pale lemon with delicate, persistent bubbles. Dry and elegant on the palate with refreshing lemon/lime notes on the zesty finish.*

### Rosé 2019

Carte Noire, Côtes De Provence, France  
*A classical styled blend of Grenache Cinsault and Syrah. A complex, vibrant red fruit, citrus and herbal tones in this crisp delight. Flowers, pimento and strawberry.*

### Rioja Tempranillo 2018

El Abuelo Organic, Spain  
*Soft balanced acidity and ripe tannic structure, the "Grandfather" is deep-coloured, with bright aromas of fig, ginger, and red fruit with smoky hint.*

### Shiraz 2017

Cathedral Cellar South Africa  
*Dark indigo colour, earthy aromas of forest mushrooms, melted chocolate mint, honey and heavily toasted marshmallow with light tannin. Dry yet fruity*

### Ripasso / Corvina 2017

Sà Solin, Italy  
*Richly aromatic with overtones of grilled herb, pekoe tea leaf and smoke accenting damson plum, red currant and licorice flavors.*

### Zinfandel 2016

Ravenswood Old Vine, California  
*A modern classic: Soft and juicy and bursting with toasted oak, nuts and dark berry fruit.*

### Malbec 2017

Viñalba Reserva, Argentina  
*Fresh and spicy with plenty of brambleberries, violets, baking spices, vanilla and cloves. Full body, tight yet velvety tannins — no shortage of plummy fruits and a fresh yet long finish.*

### Carbernet Sauvignon 2018

San Pedro 1865 Selected Vineyards, Chile  
*Good color and aromatic intensity, keeps the varietal aromas and textbook Cabernet tannins. There is good ripeness without excess.*  
Score - 90 (Louis Gutiérrez)

### Grenache/Syrah 2016

Louis Bernard Côtes du Rhône-Villages, France  
*Intensely ripe black-cherry flavor shaded by hints of barnyard, bramble and garrigue. The long finish ends on fine-grained, velvety tannins.*  
Score - 90 (Anna Lee Iijima, Wine Enthusiast, March 1, 2019)

### Pinot Noir 2018

Sacred Hill Marlborough, New Zealand  
*Delicate aromas of bright strawberry and orange rind that are backed by soft peppery spices, vanilla and roses. A satiny texture with savory tannins.*
